## 5. Make no comment or statement about the accident

For your own protection, only make comments or statements to an identified Peninsula Insurance Company representative or the police.

Using this diagram, make a sketch of the accident scene.

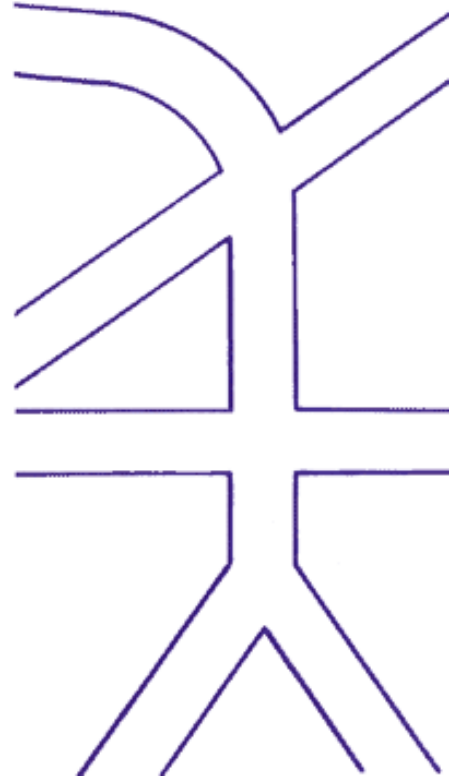
Show names of streets or highways and directions of vehicles involved. Designate your own car as "A" and other vehicles as "B", etc.

## 7. Report the accident promptly to your agent or The Peninsula Insurance Companies at

Furnish the following information:

- Your name and the insured's name on your policy.
- Your home address. Your policy number. The make and year of your car. Date, time and location of accident.
- Whether or not there were any injuries.
- Whether your car is drivable and its location if it isn't.
- Where you will be during the next few hours and a phone number where you can be reached.
